Council Meeting Minutes from December 2023

Jerusalem Evangelical Lutheran Church Council Meeting Minutes for December 14, 2023

Attendance: Jackie Brotzman, Delbert Christman, Sandy Christman, Pearl Eckhart, Wanda George, Frank Hall, Donna McGarry, Ricky Moyer, Rolf Windhorn, Bobby Ziegenfus, and Treasurer Melanie Windhorn.

Absent: Pastor Melber

Call to Order by President Ricky Moyer Devotions and Prayers: Bobby Ziegenfus

Open Forum - No discussion

Correspondence - None

Secretary's Report

- On motion by Delbert, second by Bobby and voice vote, the November 16 Council minutes and December 3 congregational minutes were approved.
- A tentative schedule of 2024 stewardship duties was presented. With the appointment of new members, this will be updated for next month's meeting.

Treasurer's Report – On motion by Donna, second by Jackie and voice vote, the Treasurer's report was approved.

Financial Secretary's Report – The current report reflects an update to monthly reports due to a calculation error found in an early-year report. On motion by Bobby, second by Pearl and voice vote, the Financial Secretary's report was approved.

Pastor's Report

- On motion by Donna, second by Jackie and voice vote, Connie Smale was appointed to a three-year term and Joan Altemose was appointed to a one-year term on Council.
- Ricky will announce at the next service that we are in need of volunteers to be at the church for the Christmas tour on December 30.
- Melanie informed Council that she has not received the monthly detail of Pastor's mileage, and asked if Council wishes to see the detail before approving the monthly mileage reimbursement. The consensus was that there is no need for Council to see the detail; if anyone on Council wants to see the report, they can access it in the office. We can discuss this at a future meeting when Pastor Ken is present.
- On motion by Frank, second by Wanda and voice vote, the Pastor's mileage reimbursement was approved in the amount of \$106.11.
- Frank Hall informed Council he will no longer be serving on Council due to medical commitments.

Ongoing and Unfinished Business

- Melanie reported that she received notification of an increase in our payroll costs. The cost has risen from \$1.75/employee/payroll to \$4/employee/payroll.
- A check issued in August to Pastor Bruce Potteiger for supply pastor services has not been cashed. Melanie contacted him, and he asked that the \$130 be sent to Food for the Poor. On motion by Delbert, second by Wanda and voice vote, this was authorized.
- Frank suggested a protocol be established for obtaining a supply pastor in Pastor Ken's absence.
- Melanie received two quotes for insurance through our new broker. \$11,833 Goodville Mutual and \$8,251 Brethren Mutual. Some changes need to be made:
 - We need to find out if we pay for worker's compensation insurance or if the parish does.
 - The stained glass windows are listed for being insured at \$25,000. After discussion, Melanie was asked to increase this to \$100,000.

Everyone thanked Melanie for doing this research. Rolf pointed out that we should require a certificate of insurance from all our contractors, and Melanie replied that she does follow through on this.

Personnel Concerns – None.

Council Member Responsibilities for January

Building Finance Steward: Because these contributions will no longer be going into a Building Fund, but rather General Fund, a separate responsibility for this is no longer necessary.

Fellowship – Sandy will continue organizing the after-service fellowship and Pearl also offered to assist. The committee that organized this year's fellowship dinner has offered to serve on the committee for our dinner in 2024.

Building & Maintenance

- We have three quotes for replacement of the two air conditioning units with heat pumps, and Rolf is waiting for one more. We will ask the successful bidder to also provide pricing for replacement of the copper piping with PEX.
- On motion by Frank, second by Bobby and voice vote, Council authorize an expenditure up to \$2,000 for replacement of the steeple lighting, to be paid from the Building Fund. George and Pat Dwinell are handling this project.
- Our signs along Route 209 are old and have the wrong church address. We aren't sure if we handle the replacement or the Synod, and Ricky will look into this.

Outreach – Sandy asked that the shut-in list be updated. Boxes were prepared and distributed, but the list was not current. Jackie stated that the shut-in list is based on the prayer list. The church Secretary needs be notified when both the prayer list and shut-in list should be changed.

Mutual Ministry

Evangelism – Bobby has been reaching out to people by phone. Delbert will be scheduling a meeting in January with people who have volunteered to serve on the committee to generate ideas on how to grow the church membership.

WELCA

- Nearly 400 pounds of filling were prepared and sold.
- The Christmas festival was well attended.
- Soup orders will be due February 4, and available for take-out only on February 9. The cost is \$8 per quart.
- Meat pie orders are due December 31, and will be available January 15 or 16. Cost is \$13 for pork or chicken, \$13 for a mix of chicken/pork, and \$15 for beef.
- The next meeting is January 2.

New Business

- Stacy will open the Church for the Christmas Eve 10:00 service and Ricky will open for the 5:00 service.
- Several items from our new Secretary:
 - Can she run a small space heater under her desk no objections.
 - ∘ Is there an office dress code no.
 - What if she needs to adjust work hours (work late, work extra hours) this needs to be cleared with Ricky for approval.
 - In the event of sickness or time away, how is this handled Ricky and Pastor Ken should be notified.
 - Who orders office supplies the Secretary orders basic supplies.
- The security system codes must be updated.
